Unexpected cost increases in capital improvements funded by a federal lessor require an increase in resources and appropriations to prepare the space for lease this fiscal year. Beginning fund balances are updated to reflect balances from our annual audit; several unexpected resources and corresponding requirements are added; overall budget figures are adjusted based on current information.
