**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE BUDGET, MAKE APPROPRIATIONS, AND IMPOSE AND**  
**CATEGORIZE THE PROPERTY TAX for FISCAL YEAR 2013-2014**

**Resolution number 2013-002**

1. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors hereby adopts the budget for Fiscal Year 2013-2014 in the total amount of \$4,915,722. The budget is now on file at the District office.
2. BE IT RESOLVED that the amounts shown below are hereby appropriated for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2013, for the following purposes:


\* *Explanation: the total appropriation amount does not equal the total amount of the adopted budget, because there are unappropriated ending fund balances and amounts reserved for future expenditure in the General Fund, the Conservation Fund, and the Building Reserve Fund. Such amounts are not appropriated. This accounts for the difference.*

3. BE IT RESOLVED that the following ad valorem property tax is hereby imposed upon the assessed value of all taxable property within the District for tax year 2013-2014, as provided for in the adopted budget:
  - At the rate of 4.9 cents per \$1,000 of assessed value for permanent rate tax.


4. BE IT RESOLVED that the tax imposed is hereby categorized for purposes of Article XI section 11b as:

	<b>Subject to the General Government Limitation</b>
<b>Permanent rate tax</b>	<b>\$0.049/\$1,000</b>
