CALL TO ORDER and AMEND/ACCEPT AGENDA/PUBLIC COMMENT

Chair Oberg called the special meeting to order with a quorum present at 2:05 p.m. on Tuesday, June 17, 2014 in the Clackamas County SWCD conference room at 221 Molalla Ave., Suite 102, in Oregon City for the purpose of Board planning with facilitator Amy Cleary.

The proposed agenda was accepted without revision.

DISCUSSION

Amy Cleary provided a brief summary of the notes from the May planning meeting.

The Board explored the advantages and disadvantages of relocating the District office to a new site including the County's Red Soils Campus, existing commercial real estate property in the Oregon City area, Clackamas Community College, the Beavercreek Farm and the Pleasant Avenue property.

The Board discussed the possibility of sharing office space with the Oregon State University Extension office, Natural Resources Conservation Service and Farm Service Area.

There was general consensus that more information was needed in order to proceed effectively.

Manager Salzer will continue to consult with area realtors to explore existing commercial properties, including flat roofed buildings, in the Oregon City area.

The Building Committee will meet to identify a design consultant who will be able to outline various construction options and potential building costs and attend a future meeting to answer Board questions.

The Board may choose to authorize Manager Salzer to issue a Qualification Based Selection (QBS) to hire a design consultant not-to-exceed \$10,000. This item will be added to the June 17, 2014 Regular Board Meeting agenda.
