STATEMENT OF CHANGES IN ACTIVITIES and SOURCES OF FINANCING

The number of people receiving service from Clackamas Soil and Water Conservation District has steadily increased, as has the District's investment in on-the-ground conservation. The District set up a Conservation Fund in FY 2012-13 to manage project-related funds and assist landowners and partners with the cost of conservation work by providing grants, cost-share, loans, and contracted services. The loan program is growing in size and scope, so in FY 2016-17, the Conservation Fund will be divided into two funds: Conservation Grants Fund (grants, cost-share, and contracted services) and Conservation Loans Fund (loans to landowners, and the loan repayment revenue is used to fund new loans to other landowners). The Working Lands Legacy Fund was set up in FY 2014-15 to preserve working lands (farms, fields, forests) by holding easements and acquiring lands for that purpose. The Building Reserve Fund is the fund the District uses to save toward a District-owned office.
