1 – CALL TO ORDER and ACCEPT AGENDA / PUBLIC COMMENT / DIRECTOR REPORTS / MANAGER'S REPORT ON COMMITTEES

- A. Call to order Chair Becker called the meeting to order at 8:32 a.m., Tuesday, January 29, 2019, in the Clackamas SWCD conference room at 221 Molalla Ave., Suite 102 in Oregon City.
 - Chair Becker stated that the purpose of the meeting was to review the Guaranteed Maximum Price amendment with P&C Construction for building the Conservation Resource Center.
- B. Public Comment There was no public Comment.

2 - DISCUSSION AND ACTION

- Director Guttridge was pleased to see that the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) of \$5,414,565 came in approximately \$100,000 under the original proposed price.
- Director Fantz was happy to note that margins had been built-in on items for which bids had not been received.
- Chair Becker asked about the source of the dollar figures used by P&C to develop the estimate. Staff Tucker noted that P&C had received bids, spoken with the architect, and engaged their staff estimator to provide the additional best estimates.

- Director Fantz noted that the time-line for the building and pay-out of funds of February 2019 to December of 2019 was short.
- Director Guttridge reported that the District should expect some delays in the time-line due to possible unforeseen circumstances.
- Director Zuber asked when the District could expect the financing to be secured. She also
 wanted to know when payments to P&C would be due. Staff Tucker reported that with the
 approval of the amendment and acceptance of the GMP he would be able to move forward
 with the District's financial broker. Tucker also hopes to have resolutions available to be
 adopted at the February and March board meetings, and funds available by March 2019. The
 District will be taking the full amount of the funding and paying the contractor directly.

<u>Directors Guttridge/Fantz moved/seconded</u> to accept Exhibit B Guaranteed Maximum Price amendment of \$5,414,565 from P&C Construction for construction of the Conservation Resource Center from February 2019 to December of 2019 as presented. <u>Motion passed unanimously.</u>
