WHEREAS money must be appropriated before it may be spent; and

WHEREAS the District has prepared a Supplemental Budget according to the requirements of ORS 294.471 and a Revised Budget incorporating those changes; and

WHEREAS the meeting at which the Supplemental Budget is being considered has been properly noticed according to the requirements of ORS 294.471,

SUMMARY of Budget Revisions: Building Reserve Fund

When the FY 2015-16 Budget was adopted, the District budgeted \$220,000 in revenue to the Building Reserve Fund from the anticipated sale of property that the District owned on Pleasant Ave. in Oregon City. In the Revised Budget, the anticipated revenue is \$356,650, of which \$221,650 shows as revenue to the Building Reserve Fund and \$135,000 shows as revenue to the General Fund. Depositing \$221,650 into the Building Reserve Fund is consistent with the Board's intent at the time the Budget was adopted.
